

## **Glencoe Golf & Country Club - Golf Dress Code & Footwear Policy**

All golfers (and volunteers) are required to adhere to and follow these standards. Those unwilling to do so will not be allowed on the golf course.

### **Acceptable Dress**

- Tailored golf slacks (which includes plus fours and Capri pants for ladies). All pants must be worn with the waistband above the hips
- Tailored shorts, skorts and golf skirts with an inseam of 6 or more inches. All shorts must be worn with the waistband above the hips
- Golf shirts with sleeves and collars, mock turtle necks (ladies golf shirts must have a collar and/or sleeves). Gentlemen's shirts must be tucked in at the waist at all times unless designed to be worn untucked (Defined as buttoned from collar to hem, hemmed and evenly cut around the bottom).
- Golf footwear with soft spikes or laced athletic running shoes on the golf course.

### **Unacceptable Dress**

- Cargo pants, zip off's, cargo shorts, exercise apparel, cut-offs or spandex
- Athletic, beach, cycling, cargo or any other shorts with an inseam less than 6 inches
- Gaudy shirts with garish, gaudy or vulgar slogans or advertising
- Blue jeans of any type
- Capri style pants for men
- Collarless shirts and t-shirts (men), halter tops, tank tops, fishnet tops and belly shirts (midriff must not be exposed)
- Clothing that is frayed, tattered and of otherwise in poor or worn out condition
- Shoes with metal or ceramic spikes, flip-flops
- Hats for men in the food and beverage areas.
